## **Spoken Treasures – The History of Vancouver and Stanley Park Through Indigenous Eyes – Walking Tour**

**Days of Tour:** Tuesday and Wednesday

**Meeting time: 2:00 PM                      End time:            3:15 PM**

**Tour Description:** Explore iconic Stanley Park and walk the seawall with Indigenous Cultural Ambassadors. Our trained Ambassador-Guides will walk with you along the seawall, a 1.1 km walk, while sharing the stories, history and lore of our great city of Vancouver and Stanley Park – through Indigenous Eyes. This tour also shares our indigenous peoples' relationship to the ocean, it's ecology and stories as well as the early contact and fascinating history of our people, with oral accounts, not yet in books, of our unique experiences with the explorers, traders, settlers and as well as the current aspects of our tribal communities today. The tour is completed at the Totem Pole park where your guide will share the true stories and real history of the people who carved them.

**Here is the info you need to know!**

This tour meets at the Stanley Park Information Booth which is accessible by car, taxi, or by foot. Our guides will meet you in front of the building beside the Interpretive Map. Please note, if driving by car, the parking lot is all pay parking. If taking the public bus, it is the #19 bus to Stanley Park and it is the last stop. From the Bus loop you will walk down the hill, via a guided path, 250 meters to the Stanley Park Information Booth. [Click here to see our map](#) is where our tour starts and ends.

The tour begins promptly at 2:00 PM so please arrive 15 minutes early to check-in with our guide. We suggest you wear comfortable shoes, clothing according to the weather since this is an outdoor activity. In summer, sunscreen, water bottle, hat, and sunglasses.

Please be advised that cancellations with 48-hour advance notice will be reimbursed with a 20% administration fee. If you would like to reschedule for another day, our company will schedule you in. Groups of four or more, if cancelling with Talaysay, we require 7 days-notice for reimbursement.

The Stanley Park Information Booth is accessed by car via Stanley Park Drive along the Sea Wall. Note: The staff at the Information Booth are not affiliated with our company so they are not aware of your tour. Your guide will be standing in front of the booth. The building is grey, it has a store front, public washrooms on the side and green tables on the south side. The Horse Drawn Tours are right beside us. Your guide is looking for you and will introduce his/herself as a Talaysay Tours guide when he, she, they meets you. We will be sure to find you.
