TALKING TREES TOUR AT STANLEY PARK

Each plant, each tree has its own special story. Explore Vancouver's iconic Stanley Park with a local Indigenous guide and cultural ambassador. Along the way, your guide will point out local plants that were harvested by First Nations people for food, technology and medicine. Options for all fitness levels.
